

# **ACTIVITY 3: AGREE OR DISAGREE LINE**

Agree Disagree Line	
Purpose	To explore differing views on rights, responsibilities, and community safety.
Time	20 - 30 minutes
Materials	N/A

## Instructions

1. Designate one end of the room as 'Strongly Agree' and the other as 'Strongly Disagree'.
2. Read statements; participants position themselves according to their view.
3. Invite volunteers to explain their reasoning.
4. After discussion, participants may move if their view changes.

## Example Statements

- Online platforms should remove harmful content more quickly.
- Public safety should sometimes take priority over individual freedoms.
- Everyone should have the right to express their opinion, even if others find it offensive.
- Young people should have more say in community decisions.
- Surveillance in public spaces helps keep communities safe.
